After attending a cocktail reception in the Emirates Palace, the dignitaries streamed into the auditorium for the Zayed Future Energy prize-giving ceremony.

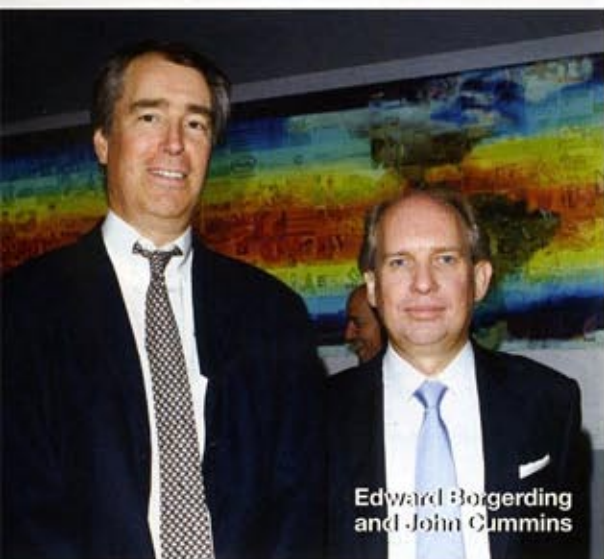
